

2026 Equity Fund - Evidence Guide

Below are examples of the types of documents the Future of Education Equity Fund needs to assess your application.

1. Centrelink card

The Fund will accept a copy of your physical card, or a screenshot of your card from the Express Plus Centrelink mobile app or the myGov app.

The following cards can be provided as evidence of low-income:

Health Care Card



Pensioner Concession Card



Card codes FO, CD, MO, & DSP Blind, and cards issued to dependents, are not eligible.

2. Alternative evidence of low-income

If you do not have a current income tested Centrelink card, you can still apply by providing your most recent **Notice of Assessment from the Australian Taxation Office** (see example below) along with evidence of your **income for the 8-weeks** prior to submitting your application.

If you are applying as a couple, you'll also need to include evidence of your partner's income.

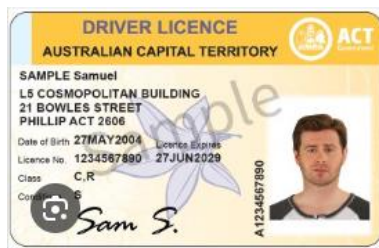

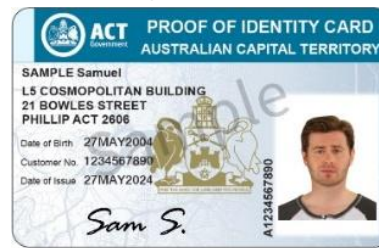
